## Portfolio Lead, Southern Medical Program (SMP)

The University of British Columbia, Southern Medical Program (SMP) invites applications for the position of Portfolio Lead. This is a 3-year term appointment, renewable, subject to a satisfactory performance review. The time commitment is 0.05. FTE, equivalent to one day per month. The position requires on-site activity at the Reichwald Health Science Centre (RHS) at UBC Okanagan campus.

The Southern Medical Program (SMP) is a distributed undergraduate medical education program within the University of British Columbia's Faculty of Medicine. The Portfolio lead, SMP oversees the recruitment of SMP Portfolio coaches and ensures the ongoing sustainability of the SMP Portfolio program.

The incumbent is accountable to the Regional Associate Dean, Interior and reports to the provincial Portfolio Assessment Lead on operational matters. Collaboration with provincial and local faculty leadership and managers across the UGME program is essential to ensure the goals, objectives and exit competencies of the clerkship are met Curriculum Management - MedNet.
